**Footnotes**

BLACKBERRY WINTER stalked the pace about the three path, started a three wide bid nearing the five sixteenths pole, dueled to the front past the quarter, was clear in mid turn then drifted outward while under a hardy drive to hold off the challenge of Island Love through the final sixteenth. ISLAND LOVE settled close inside, eased out with a bid nearing the quarter pole, rounded the final turn four wide, reached the outside flank of the winner while being carried outward and was gaining slowly on that one. BEAT THE SPREAD rated a slim lead inside, was pressured from the three eighths pole, yielded control into the final turn then leveled off from midstretch. BAD AS IN GOOD settled back off the rail, started his bid leaving the first turn, entered the stretch three wide then leveled off toward the wire. TREASURE TRIP broke outward, settled well back from the early pace while saving ground, bid nearing the five sixteenths pole, eased five wide through the final turn then leveled off down the lane. BROOKS IN TOWN chased the pace from the outside, saved some ground on the final turn but showed little further down the lane. KID COTTON rated with the early pace two deep, gave chase leaving the three eighths pole and loomed a close factor to the quarter before fading. NARROW BACK, four wide the first turn, was through early. DSPITE ALL MY RAGE raced well back toward the outside. DEMOLISHER came away awkwardly, steadied right out of the gate, was shut off at that point, raced wide the first turn and not a factor.
