SWISSLE STICK led throughout on the rail, prevailed under urging. MOUNTAIN MAN moved up along the inside, angled out for the drive, finished strongly. KID CARSON advanced four wide down the backstretch, angled to the rail on the turn, finished with good energy. ONE IN THE MIDDLE forced the issue three wide, lacked a late response. MEDITERRANEAN SEA with the pace just off the rail, lacked a closing bid. LOGAN'S RALLY flashed early speed three and four wide, lacked the needed rally. EUTAW RUN never was a threat, four and five wide. JOY TO THE LIGHT five wide along the backstretch, was no factor. SUPER BRILLIANT broke in the air, showed little. KING OF THE ROAD had brief foot, five wide.
