Footnotes

REGAL COMPANY stalked the pace two deep the opening turn, took over at the half mile pole, rated his speed to the five sixteenths, was urged from that point to draw clear on the final turn then dug in under steady encouragement to maintain. BANXIOUSFORNOTHING had a slim lead inside the opening turn, kept up under steady urging down the backstretch and kept close aim to late stretch before leveling off. SMOKEN BOBBE showed no speed inside, steadily improved near the rail rounding the final turn and finished evenly. UNLIMITED BUD remained in close chase off the rail to the sixteenth pole before leveling off. SPANISH AFFAIR, off the pace and off the rail, showed no response on the final turn. CAPTAIN KIRKLAND became fractious and ran loose in the post parade, gave brief close chase four wide, saved ground entering the first turn and was no further factor. SILVER PIONEER checked four wide at the heels of Captain Kirkland into the first turn and never factored. KID KLARE, in close early chase, angled six wide into the first turn and trailed thereafter.
