T. V. SECRETARY rushed up five wide down the backstretch, gained the lead three wide on the turn, drew off under a steady drive. BEL CHATEAU set the pace inside and while unable to gain on the winner was easily second best. DO NO WRONG bumped at the start, stalked the pace three wide, failed to respond. VERSATILES SECRET rallied three wide around the turn but failed to sustain her bid. DIANA MOSELEY never threatened four wide. SLEW SALLY SLEW ducked out and bumped with DO NO WRONG at the start, prompted the pace four wide, lacked a late bid. STAMFORD BRIDGE close up early, fell back. PIN AND PECK was used up after a half, three wide. WHATAROCKET trailed on the rail.
