Footnotes

BEENIE bore out at the start, was unhurried while saving ground around the first turn, advanced outside down the backstretch, raced two wide around the far turn and closed strongly through the gain to get up in deep stretch and win going away. FORTY THIEVES set the pace along the rail, brushed with SONOFAWILDCAT entering the first turn, drew clear leaving the three-sixteenths pole, held clear past the sixteenth pole and weakened late while continuing on his left lead. BAY BUTTON BILL lacked speed along the rail, advanced inside nearing the far turn and finished willingly to gain the show without threatening the top two. SONOFAWILDCAT brushed with FORTY THIEVES nearing the first turn and bumped SIR CAPITULATION soon after, pressed the pace in the two path and faded midway around the far turn. SIR CAPITULATION was bumped entering the first turn, prompted the pace three wide around that bend and gave way nearing the far turn. VALUE YOUR ANGEL was bumped entering the first turn, stalked the pace four wide around that bend and tired down the backstretch.
