CANADIAN SUMMER four wide along the backstretch, dropped to the rail on the turn, angled four wide for the drive then was up late. KASSI'S LOVE set the pace on the rail, drew off around the turn, led until the final strides while drifting out late. HENRY'S POSSE advanced five and six wide, closed with a rush through the lane. MUSICTOTHEEARS moved up along the rail, angled out some for the drive then steadied while lacking room in late stretch. WINDY CORNER pressed the issue just off the rail, finished well. NOLANA saved ground, rallied four wide around the turn and finished strongly. TUFTIKUS three wide along the backstretch, came seven wide around the turn and finished willingly. SNOWMOBILE up close three wide, fell back around the turn.
