Footnotes

AMARILLO SKY stalked the pace three wide, advanced three deep around the far turn, reached even terms turning for home and drove clear. HAVING SAID THAT was unhurried while saving ground around the first turn, began to inch closer inside down the backstretch, tipped into the two path to advance around the far turn and finished strongly through the lane to gain the place. DESERT TIGER disputed the pace two wide around the first turn, took command down the backstretch, was collared by the winner turning for home and lost the place in deep stretch. VALUED TRUST lacked speed in the two path, raced five wide around the far turn and passed tiring rivals. CAPTAIN CAGEY failed to menace while racing two wide. DAYTIME disputed the pace along the rail and tired around the far turn. TROOPER D settled off the pace in the clear while saving ground early and dropped back in the four path around the far turn. A. P. BEST trailed well off the rail.
