ACROSS THE WIND pressed the issue just off the rail, gained the lead down the backstretch, held clear thereafter under a drive. MILES CITY stalked the leaders three wide, bid around the turn and was easily second best. MAN OF THE UNKNOWN off a step slow and squeezed back at the start, passed tiring rivals four wide. REFINED DESIGN saved ground, came four wide around the turn, never threatened in the drive. PANIOLO set the pace on the rail, dug in along the backstretch, gave way around the turn. NIGHT TIMER prompted the issue three wide, tired. PRAIRIE BOY had little left after three quarters on the rail. BALLTWNOSTRIKES forced the pace from the inside, stopped after six furlongs.
