Footnotes

BEBOPPIN BETTY up close early from the outside, crept closer up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, gained command and steadily drew clear. MISS LOTAWATA broke sharp from the inside, gained a clear early margin, remained clear up the backstretch, held a forward position entering the second turn but was no match for the winner. BELLA UNO stalked the early pace from the outside, crept closer entering the second turn, responded and finished well but too late. MORE AMOUR well placed from the inside, had nothing left for the drive. HOLD was no factor. ROCKY'S ANGEL chased the early pace and tired. HIDDEN BLUFF was never close. BARBIE'S Q T BEAR was pulled up entering the second turn and vanned off.
