Footnotes

STRIKE THE MOON stalked the pace three wide, launched a three deep bid near the quarter pole, quickly swept to command, drew clear leaving the three-sixteenths pole, widened in upper stretch and held safe under strong left-handed urging in the final sixteenth. GROUPIE DOLL lagged along the inside through the opening half, swung four wide to advance nearing the quarter pole, rallied around the turn, swung six wide nearing the lane, lugged in under right-handed urging in upper stretch, straightened out and surged under left-handed urging to close much of the gap in the final sixteenth. MY SUNSHINE GAL set the pace along the rail, was collared leaving the quarter pole, chased the winner from the inside around the rest of the turn and held well to preserve the show. HOT SUMMER was unhurried in the two path around the first turn, began to advance three wide between rivals near the five-sixteenths pole, angled to the rail leaving the three-sixteenths marker and finished willingly inside of foes to just miss the show. WITHGREATPLEASURE bumped with COAX LIBERTY early, stalked the pace from the rail and weakened in the lane. HER SMILE angled out and bumped with TOURMALINE approaching the wire the first time, drifted out a bit into the first turn, raced four wide around that bend, edged closer down the backstretch, made a slight gain four wide around the far turn, steadied when GROUPIE DOLL lugged in in front of her in upper stretch, shifted out soon after and lacked the need rally. COAX LIBERTY was bumped and in tight early, tracked the pace two wide between rivals and came up empty. GRAND KISSES broke outwardly, prompted the pace two wide, bid two wide between rivals at the quarter pole but gave way nearing the lane. TOURMALINE was bumped nearing the wire the first time, raced five wide around the first turn, continued wide around the far turn and dropped back. PRINCESS CECILIA was in tight just after the start, saved ground and never factored.
