THREE YEAR OLD FILLIES. Free nominations. Nominations close Saturday, September 4, 2010. \$750 to pass entry box, \$400,000 guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing seventh through last, 60% to owner of winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to sixth. Weight 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stake allowed 3 lbs., non-winners of a stakes race since June 1, allowed 5 lbs., non-winners of \$30,000 since July 1, allowed 7 lbs., non-winners of a race other than maiden or claiming since then allowed 9 lbs. Field limited to ten starters with four on the alternates list. Supplemental nominations may be made at the time of entry Wednesday, September 15, 2010 by payment of \$12,500 each (includes all fees). Preference to stakes winners in order (Grade I, Grade II, Grade III), then stakes winners, then highest lifetime earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Trophy to winning owner, trainer and jockey.

DERWIN'S STAR with the leaders, stalked the pace three wide, moved to a clear lead around the turn then maintained her margin through the stretch under steady urging. BRONX CITY GIRL made a steady advance three and four wide, loomed boldly around the turn but failed to sustain her bid in the lane. C C'S PAL off the pace four and five wide, was set down around the turn to become a strong factor at the top of the stretch but came up empty in the drive. SOUTHERN FIREBALL prompted the issue just off the rail, remained a strong factor around the turn but weakened in the stretch run. DOWN TOWN ALLEN made a clear lead early, dug in along the backstretch, gave way around the turn. BEYONDALLBOUNDARYS forced the pace along the inside, lacked the needed rally when asked in the drive. KARMAGEDDON well placed inside, lacked a late response. COME SUNDAY off a step slow, showed little three and four wide. BELLE OF THE HALL within striking distance three wide for a half, dropped back quickly around the turn and had little left for the drive.
