Footnotes

CRACKER JACK DAD stalked the pace off the rail, moved to the front two deep near the nine sixteenths pole, was urged clear to widen from the three eighths then kept alert down the lane. CROWN COURT settled back off the rail, started a bid leaving the three eighths pole, steadily improved in the four path of the final turn and was along for place. NICK FROM ARVERNE, unhurried toward the outside, made a bid past the seven sixteenths pole, saved some ground on the final turn then leveled off in the stretch. FLANK DA MAN rated a short lead inside, was caught approaching the nine sixteenths pole, gave chase from that point then faded rounding the final turn. PROUD ERA, well back toward the outside, made no significant gain after saving ground on the final turn. A. P. HEAVEN ROSE settled close about the three path, gave chase from the seven sixteenths pole then faded approaching the final turn. DEVIL CAREER was kept off the early pace inside then faded after a half mile. ALLAMAGNIFIQUE and SUPREME NOTION were not factors.
