SMART PRO saved ground, angled out on the turn, gained the lead in the upper stretch then drew off. MARTI BE LUCKY stalked the pace three and four wide, was second best. O'LARCAIN well placed inside, lacked a late response. GINI GO GO found her best stride late along the rail. CAFE DRIVE set the pace on a clear lead, weakened in the stretch. RUGGED TRAIL failed to menace. SHEEZAWILDKAT never threatened. PRETTY TRUE showed little. DOUGH RE MI was no factor.
