**Footnotes**

SEVERN SHORE angled out entering the first turn, stalked the pace three wide, moved three deep around the far turn, took the lead turning for home and edged ahead under a drive. RITA HAYWOOD led along the rail early, settled back leaving the five-eighths pole, angled out leaving the half-mile pole, moved two wide to reach even terms entering the far turn, vied between foes from the three-sixteenths pole and was outfinished. PAGAN JEWEL set the pace two wide around the first turn, angled to the rail down the backstretch, vied inside around the far turn and weakened in the lane. OK LISTEN UP saved ground throughout and was never a threat. D D'S DESTINY stumbled at the start, chased the pace four wide and tired around the far turn. SHE'S MY MONSTER was outrun inside.
