Footnotes

HOT SAUCE rated close two deep, challenged the pacesetter nearing the five sixteenths pole, contested a slim advantage from the quarter pole and dug in under determined handling to edge that one out in a heated stretch battle. BUCKLE BUNNY BABE rated a short lead inside, was pressured toward the five sixteenths pole, caught a pole later, contested at a disadvantage rounding the final turn then grudgingly yielded after a game stretch duel. RAPID VICTORY stalked the pace off the rail, gave chase toward the three eighths pole then leveled off through the lane. DEVONSPAINTEDLADY exchanged light contact with Thefun'sjustbegun leaving the gate, settled well back off the rail then passed a tired rival in the stretch. THEFUN'SJUSTBEGUN exchanged light contact with Devonspaintedlady leaving the gate, stalked the pace about the three path, gave chase from the three eighths pole then weakened in the lane. BAILEY BLUEYES settled back off the rail and was not a factor.
