Footnotes

ISLAND WILD CAT prompted the issue three wide, made a clear lead on the turn, drew off through the stretch while kept to a drive. EDDIE LOVES MONEY advanced three and four wide, finished well. CERRADOR set the pace just off the rail, remained a factor around the turn, weakened in the drive. SANDRO PAZZO moved up four and five wide, finished strongly. SOCIAL RIDER stalked the leaders four wide, lacked a late response. ALL WORK flashed early speed along the inside, steadied into the turn and fell back. SALTY four and five wide, lacked a closing bid while steadying in mid stretch while tiring. GREAT NORTON saved ground, eased out four wide around the turn, never threatened in the drive. RED ROCK DIAMOND well placed inside, bore out around the turn and retreated. SARATOGIAN off a step slow then in tight at the start, was well placed inside, tried to rally around the turn, clipped heels with ALL WORK in mid stretch and lost his rider.
