Footnotes

PEACEFUL BLISS took over three wide past the nine sixteenths pole, rated clear off the rail through the backstretch, was urged into the lane and under moderate encouragement to wide. GOLD STANDARD raced unhurriedly and well back toward mid track, bid leaving the three eighths pole, saved ground on the final turn and held on for place while no match for the winner. PROUD PLUCK trailed the field the opening half mile, started his bid leaving the three eighths pole, was swung six wide through the final turn and closed strong for show. CLARKE COUNTY, off the pace and off the rail, eased to the five path making a bid at the five sixteenths pole but leveled off through the lane. TROUBLE MAKIN, off the pace and off the rail, made a mild bid in mid track on the backstretch but lacked further response on the final turn. BUBBA DE FRANCE raced close to the early pace inside then faded down the backstretch. DR. SPOCK stalked the early pace off the rail but was through after a half mile. REPRESENTATIVE stalked the pace two deep, gave chase from the half mile pole then weakened saving ground on the final turn.
