LONGANDSTRONG broke alertly, set the pace under heavy pressure throughout and was all out to hold off SENOR FUEGO at the end. SENOR FUEGO sat outside the winner in perfect position, dug in through the stretch but dropped a close decision in a strong effort. COLONEL J W forced the issue just off the rail, rallied around the turn, finished willingly through the stretch. EARLY STAR prompted the pace three wide, angled five wide for the drive but came up empty in the lane. TERMSOFENGAGEMENT trailed for a half, tried to rally along the rail around the turn but could not gain appreciably in the drive. CAME EAST within striking distance four wide, lacked the needed late rally.
