EZTOPOINT unhurried early from the inside, steadily advanced up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, altered outside for the drive and steadily drew clear. LET'S TRADE dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch, remained in a forward position entering the drive but could not keep pace. QUARTERBACK SNEAK allowed to settle early, advanced outside, reached a striking position entering the second turn, responded and was gaining late. KARL'S RIVER CARD dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained engage up the backstretch but tired in the drive. THEPOWERSINYOU went evenly. DANGLINGONTHEEDGE was no factor. PASSING LANE was no threat. SECOND TO NONE had a steady fade. JOHNNYSK was always outrun.
