COLONEL J W forced the issue just off the rail, made his bid around the turn, gained the lead nearing the sixteenth pole then was all out to last. LIVELY REPARATIONS saved ground, rallied five wide on the turn, closed with a rush through the lane. NO MORE JEALOUSY pressed the pace from the inside, made a slim lead in the upper stretch but was out finished. HE'S COMING AROUND well placed inside, rallied to contention on the turn but failed to sustain his bid. EL NUMERO UNO saved ground, came five wide on the turn, lacked a closing bid. TROUBLE MAKIN set the pace on the rail, gave way in the drive. LIL DALE stalked the leaders three and four wide, lacked the needed rally. I'M FUHR REAL showed early speed, steadily faded. EL PISTON showed little, four and five wide. BIG ROUGE never was a factor, three wide.
