Footnotes

A GOOD RUN dueled from the inside for the early lead, shook loose entering the turn, opened a clear margin at the eighth pole and was clear while kept to task. SHORT HILL KIT KAT stalked the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the turn, remained along the rail entering the drive, was erratic entering the drive, drifted in and out upper stretch bothering rivals, recovered and was gaining late. After a Jockey's claim of foul and review from the Stewards', SHORT HILL KIT KAT was disqualified for interference in the upper stretch. BONNIE DE CASTLE dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained forward for the drive but could not keep pace. IDEAL THOUGHTS up close early from the inside, altered outside entering the turn, was bothered upper stretch when SHORT HILL KIT KAT drifted in and out, recovered and finished gamely late. HOW IS MY GIRL well placed from the inside, had nothing left for the drive. PRINCESS PUFF was no factor. FLO JO'S AFFAIR was no threat. I'M HEFE had little impact. RITZY STORED had little interest. CLASSY SOCIETY was outrun.
