**Footnotes**

DEVIL'S CANDY rated close to the early pace about the three path, took aim past the seven sixteenths pole, moved to the front a furlong later, was pressured into the lane and held well with steady handling. PAST YOUR EYES, boxed at the rail on the first turn, bid in the three path leaving the three eighths pole, took aim approaching the final turn and finished evenly to be second best. SHE SURE IS settled back off the rail, bid nearing the five sixteenths pole then leveled off down the lane. AVERY'S ANGEL, well back and off the rail, bid past the five sixteenths pole and finished evenly to pass tiring rivals. GHOSTLY SKY was kept back of the early pace off the rail and showed little response through the backstretch. PREACH LOVE rated a short lead off the rail, was pressured leaving the seven sixteenths pole, caught a furlong later and faded on the final turn. MARY'S PRIZE raced well back saving ground. PAINTER'S LADY settled close to the early pace about the four path but faded rounding the first turn. KARDOKAN, five wide the opening turn, was not a factor. DUDDIE PRINDERELLA saved ground.
