MILL STONE gained a slim lead down the backstretch, drew off around the turn, held clear under a drive. MC TAGGART advanced three wide to be second best. LIVELY REPARATIONS moved up along the rail but was no match for the top two. SENSENY ROAD prompted the issue three and four wide, lacked a late response. NICOLES PROSPECT set the pace inside, gave way around the turn. LEEWAY DANCER made little impact on the rail. RICHWOOD HALL forced the issue just off the rail, tired.
