Footnotes

SOUND AFFAIR set a rated pace along the rail, drew clear under urging around the far turn and held clear through the lane while continuing on his left lead. TOREADOR stalked the pace three wide around both turns and finished willingly to gain the place without threatening the winner. HEY THERE stalked the pace from the rail, lost some ground while angling four wide midway around the far turn and finished well on his left lead to gain the show. WHITE POST went evenly along the rail. WOHALI hustled up to take the lead in the early stages, settled for a prompting position outside of the winner around the first turn, continued two wide around the far turn and weakened. GOLDEN RETIREMENT failed to menace while racing three wide. BREWSTER COUNTY saved ground to no avail. STORMIN' YANKEE hesitated at the start and raced four and five wide throughout. ESPIRITO was outrun inside.
