Footnotes

MISCHIEVOUS MAYBRY rated a slim lead inside, contested a slight advantage through the final turn, bore out entering the stretch then lugged inward while wavering lanes late. PUNCH LIKE A GIRL rated with the pace while alternating for control with the winner between calls, challenged that one from the five sixteenths pole, contested at a slight disadvantage rounding the final turn and dug in a close stretch factor. RICH JOKE settled back off the rail, bid leaving the three eighths pole, saved ground on the final turn and finished evenly. TINKERTWEET, well back toward mid track, bid nearing the quarter pole, angled outward on the final turn, entered the stretch about the six path and finished evenly outside. OIDOS DE CONEJO lost ground making light contact with Makin Halos into the first turn, was kept just off the pace most of the backstretch then weakened approaching the final turn. LEX'S SWEET GIRL was outrun while saving ground. CAT'S LAST TANGO, reluctant to load, leapt from the gate and never factored. MAKIN HALOS was brushed four wide into the first turn, gave chase for a half mile then faded.
