Footnotes

CLASSICA prompted the pace three wide around the first turn, reached even terms outside of PURSES GALORE near the seven-sixteenths pole, duelled two wide from there to upper stretch and drove clear. WHAT A GIFT stalked the pace from the rail, went three wide between foes around the far turn, shifted further out in upper stretch and rallied for the place. MAGGY MAC was unhurried along the inside, circled six wide around the far turn and finished well too late outside. PURSES GALORE pressed the pace two wide between foes around the first turn, took the lead near the seven-sixteenths pole, duelled inside of the winner from there to midstretch then weakened. CHICKADEDEDEE stalked the pace three wide between foes, went four wide between rivals around the far turn and came up empty in the lane. STEAMBOAT ANNIE set the early pace along the rail and tired nearing the far turn. WARRIOR WALTZ was reluctant to load and outrun while racing three to six wide.
