PEELAPEAR pressed the pace from the inside, angled out for the drive, gained the lead nearing the sixteenth pole then drove clear. ANOTHER UNA rushed up the inside, steadied down the backstretch, finished strong four wide. LADY SILK set the pace on a clear lead but was out finished. NATIVE VOODOO stalked the pace four wide, finished well. MAIKA MY DINNER bid five wide around the turn, closed willingly. J. D. PRINCESS steadied repeatedly along the rail down the backstretch, closed ground in the drive. O'LARCAIN passed tiring rivals. MARFARITA hard used, tired. BOLD SKY five and six wide, lacked a late response. RICH AND LUCKY showed little. The rider of ANOTHER UNA claimed foul against the winner for alleged interference down the backstretch. The stewards reviewed the video tape replays and found not evidence of a foul and allowed the original order of finish to stand.
