MAXIVISION, quickly in command, rated the pace inside, drew off under a mild hand ride proving much the best. RIPLEYS REVENGE chased the pace inside, eased out entering the stretch, leveled off in the drive and settled for second best. CHARMING COWGIRL chased the early pace from the outside, saved ground through the turn then leveled out in the lane. COPPER RIVER QUEST chased the pace widest, came through the turn six wide and had little left in the stretch. BEAUTIFUL BRANDY showed no speed well back inside, eased outward on the turn, entered the lane five wide and passed tiring rivals. MISS PUDDIN chased the early pace two deep then faded rounding the turn. GOLDEN GALLOP, a step slow to break, raced well back inside and passed tiring rivals. BEACHED LADY showed no speed inside and was vanned off post race. PENNSY AVENUE was not a factor. CLASSICAL'S HOPE chased the pace four wide, dropped back through the turn, was eased in the stretch but walked off.
