C V'S DEVELEN settled off the pace along the rail, advanced two wide just outside of and in tandem with PREMIER'S WHINNY around the far turn, closed outside, took the lead in midstretch, dueled outside from there and prevailed. PREMIER'S WHINNY was unhurried along the inside, rallied along the rail just inside of the winner, angled out in upper stretch, closed between foes and just missed. PANTASTIC had his head turned at the start, lacked speed while racing three wide, went four wide around the far turn and was just up for the show. BIG JIMMY J. sprinted clear to set the pace along the rail, led to midstretch and tired. WHY BILL WHY lacked speed inside, raced four wide around the far turn and rallied belatedly. PRINCE NOIR chased the pace three wide and came up empty around the far turn. TYLER'S JEWEL saved ground and failed to menace. THE PACK IS BACK was not a factor while racing two and three wide. D K'S WILDCAT chased the pace inside and tired around the far turn. UNSHATTERABLE had brief speed three wide. A claim of foul from the rider of PREMIER'S WHINNY against the winner for alleged interference around the far turn was not allowed.
