STAR OF TAURUS broke well from the inside to gain a clear early margin, dueled up the backstretch with CATS ZIP, shook loose from that one entering the second turn, opened a clear margin entering the drive and was well clear the final furlong. CATS ZIP well placed from the inside early, dueled up the backstretch with the winner but could not match strides. HOLLY GO LIVELY stalked the early pace from between foes, advanced up the backstretch, remained in a forward position entering the drive but could not keep pace. FIVEFIFTYFIVE pressed the early pace from the outside, remained in a forward position entering the drive but had nothing left. FFFABULOUSLY FLEET was never a threat. DIVINE PLAN stumbled at the start, was six wide into the first turn and no factor in a troubled trip. WEEKENDONTHEMOON chased the early pace inside and tired.
