PAGAN JEWEL chased the pace off the rail, drifted outward while progressing through the turn, entered the stretch in the six path, rallied clear inside the sixteenth pole and under steady handling to widen. CANDLE OF GOLD, hustled for early control, rated the pace to the middle of the turn, came under pressure from that point, yielded to the winner inside the sixteenth pole then lasted for place. LA CHUPACABRA chased the pace off the rail and finished evenly while gaining on the runner-up. DI COLAS HOLIDAY chased the pace toward mid track then leveled out in the lane. GRUMPSHERGRANNY saved ground to the top of the lane and had no rally. KICK ASH gave distant chase from mid track. VELVET CURTINS and ELEGANT DIAMOND both saved ground and were not factors.
