Footnotes

PLANKING moved to the front at the three quarter pole to rate the pace inside, was pressured toward the five sixteenths pole and held on under steady stretch encouragement. AVIDDIVA settled just off the pace inside, started a bid at the three eighths pole and was edging closer through the lane. FINAL BOW rated off the pace about the four path, bid leaving the three eighths pole though leveled off down the lane. GIN'S DANDY GIRL, well off the pace and off the rail, bid leaving the half mile pole then leveled off rounding the final turn. HIGH FLYING RAVEN saved ground off the early pace and made a mild bid off the rail rounding the final turn. SOUTH COAST HARBOR raced well back toward mid track and passed only tiring rivals. OUR YORKIE, off the pace outside, showed no response from the three eighths pole. FRISKY DIXIE hesitated at the start and never factored. BRADY'S NEW CAT dropped back from a brief lead to settle close inside the opening turn then faded from the half mile pole.
