Footnotes

TRUCKEE WHISP stalked the leaders while saving ground around the first turn, ranged up on the outside down the backstretch to reach near even terms with EXECUTIVE SHANE entering the far turn, duelled outside of that rival to mid stretch, briefly drew clear in late stretch then just lasted. WILD AND TRICKY was unhurried inside early, rallied three wide around the far turn, came five wide into the lane and closed with a rush. FAMOUS FROLIC was off a step slow, raced three wide around the first turn, rallied three wide around the far turn, finished willingly. EXECUTIVE SHANE forced the issue inside, made a rail bid to take the lead nearing the three-eighths pole, vied inside the winner from the five-sixteenths pole to the sixteenth pole then gave way late. B RULES lacked speed while racing along the rail early, moved up in the two path around the far turn, lacked the necessary closing bid. KITE HAWK pressed the pace while racing between horses around the clubhouse turn, faded backstretch. UNCLE HOWARD stumbled just after the start, was never a factor. POINT SAM set a pressured pace along the rail, tired down the backstretch. HOLY INTENTIONS vied three-wide for the early lead, retreated around the far turn.
