SHORT BUT SWEET dueled two wide through the opening half-mile, drew clear rounding the far turn, drifted out under right-handed urging in the lane and held well. THAT'S IT FOR ME settled off the pace along the inside, advanced three wide around the far turn and was slowly gaining on the winner in the lane. ANNIE LOU raced two wide throughout and finished well between foes to gain the show in deep stretch. R TAKELA lagged inside for five furlongs and rallied belatedly between rivals. CAROL SNUCK IN stalked the pace two wide came up empty in the lane. PRIZE OF PROSPECT failed to menace while racing three and four wide. NORTH SLIDE DANCER was no threat while racing two and three wide. RIVER WALTZ dueled inside of the winner through the opening half-mile and tired. MARY FORBES saved ground to no avail. STONEFELS DELILAH raced three wide and never factored.
