Footnotes

EXHORTER settled close about the three path, moved to the front leaving the three eighths pole, was urged away rounding the final turn then steadily handed down the lane. DEVIL CAREER, pinched back at the start, settled well back off the rail, made a bid while angling outward on the final turn, entered the stretch five wide and finished evenly to be second best. DEUTERIUM, well back toward the outside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, rounded the final turn three wide and was along for show. FAMILY FAITH rated just off the early pace off the rail, started a bid nearing the three eighths pole then leveled out down the lane. DANCING OLLIE, pinched back at the start, gave chase toward mid track and improved to the final turn before leveling off. D WAG became fractious behind the gate unseating his rider, chased the early pace off the rail then leveled off toward mid track. WIN THE GREEN had a slim lead inside the opening turn, dropped back past the nine sixteenths pole, gave chase from that point but had no further response past the three eighths pole. ANGRY LIL STINKBUG was not a factor. WOODFORD ROAD, five wide the opening turn, saved ground from the nine sixteenths pole but was through early. MR. CATALPA broke awkwardly and in, rated with the early pace two deep, took the lead nearing the nine sixteenths pole, was caught toward the five sixteenths pole, the rider seemed to have little control, was eased on the final turn but walked off post race. NOTE: Prior the start of this race, Mr. Catalpa was returned to the gate for a bridle adjustment.
