HOLBORN CIRCLE set the pace three wide and widened under urging. FORMAL CAT TOUCH off the pace three and four wide, rallied around the turn to be clearly second best. GROOVY EXPLOSION prompted the issue from the inside, lacked a late response. SYNCOPATED SILVER five wide along the backstretch, bid three wide around the turn but was too late. NAPOLEON J stalked the leaders along the inside, failed to respond. BUCK TOUR in tight at the start, passed tiring rivals. SKY LINE DRIVE bobbled at the start then was no factor. FAST FREDDIE forced the issue three wide, tired. JOLLIYAT saved ground to no avail. MR TWEAL'S UP stopped after a half along the rail.
