SILVER HEART well placed from the inside, crept closer entering the second turn, responded when sat down for the drive and steadily drew clear. WAY TO FLY stalked the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the second turn, made a bid to gain the advantage at the eighth pole but could not last. SPRINGTIME FROLIC duelled from between foes for the early lead, duelled up the backstretch, remained forward entering the drive but could not keep pace. MEDICINEFILE outrun early, advanced entering the second turn, responded and was gaining late. MY WILDEST DREAMS forced the early pace from the outside but could only improve position. TAMBOZ chased the early pace from the inside and tired. SNUCK IN FOR FREE duelled from the inside and tired. DECK THE HALL was never close. WAKE UP MAGGIE duelled from the outside and gave way.
