MASTIC VILLAGE alternated on the lead while four wide, lost the lead around the turn, came again to be up on the wire. PERFECT WAY alternated for the lead, edged clear on the turn, led until the final strides. STORMY CITY prompted the pace three and four wide, finished strongly. FURRFIELD CAT forced the issue four and five wide, closed with a rush through the lane. SPEEDY TUXEDO within striking distance along the inside, swung out five wide on the turn, finished well. DOTS RECORD SHOP flashed early speed inside, lacked a late response. WELCOME CITI brushed the rail into the turn but was no threat. RED ROCK DIAMOND flashed brief foot on the rail. MEDSHOW sluggish at the start, trailed four wide.
