INCRIVAL VENCEDOR stalked the early pace from the outside, inched closer up the backstretch, dueled with REBEL ROAR through the second turn, gained a clear margin deep stretch and was clear late. REBEL ROAR broke sharp from the inside to gain a clear early margin, remained clear up the backstretch, dueled with the winner through the second turn, remained forward for the drive but could not match strides. I'M A STORM TOO chased the early pace from the outside, steadily advanced up the backstretch, responded but was too late. DIRTEATER well placed from the inside, remained forward for the drive but could not keep pace. KARL'S RIVER CARD chased the early pace outside but had nothing left. INTO THE NIGHT went evenly. MELINI was no factor. BLACK TIE DINNER was no threat. HERO'S END had a steady fade.
