Footnotes

FIRST COLONY stalked the early pace two deep, took command at the quarter pole, was soon clear and steadily handled through the lane. LADS STARLIT rated off the pace about the three path, saved ground making a bid past the three eighths pole and finished well in the duel for place. FIVE ALARM CHILLI, four wide the first turn, stalked the pace three wide down the backstretch, bid leaving the quarter pole then outfinished in the duel for place. BRAZILIAN WEDDING raced well back toward mid track, bid from the quarter pole and finished evenly. CONGRESIONALAFFAIR rated a short lead inside, came under pressure leaving the five sixteenths pole, contested at a disadvantage through the final turn then gave way from the head of the lane. MISS CATRINA rated close to the early pace inside then faded through the backstretch. ELUSIVE APPEAL came away a step slow and was not a factor. EVER YOURS was eased shortly after the start walked off.
