Footnotes

MYSTICAL NOTION settled off the early pace off the rail, kept aim through the backstretch, bid toward the five sixteenths pole, entered the stretch four wide and dug in from there to get up the final strides. **INNER POWER** rated close to the pace inside, was boxed in through the final turn, squeezed into an opening at the rail entering the stretch, took the lead at the sixteenth pole but was outfinished the closing strides. **BIG JIMMY J.**, hesitant to load, stalked the pace two deep, bid toward the five sixteenths pole, contested the final turn three wide and continued in close chase to late stretch before leveling off. **ALLEN'S MONSTER** accelerated to the front for inside position to rate the pace, was urged from the five sixteenths pole, contested the rail rounding the final turn, continued under a hard drive to maintain the advantage in the upper stretch but weakened at the sixteenth pole. **MILWAUKEE FUN** rated back toward the outside down the backstretch, bid at the five sixteenths pole, came through the final turn five wide and finished evenly. **GREEN RECRUIT** rated back off the rail and had no response on the final turn. **REPRESENTATIVE**, awkward at the break, came out making contact with the gate and Christmas Holiday, stalked the pace three wide, bid leaving the three eighths pole and had aim to the top of the lane before weakening. **I GOT'M** was no factor while saving ground. **CHRISTMAS HOLLADAY**, bumped at the start, settled off the pace about the four path, angled to the outside on the final turn and had nothing further in the lane. **BEST TO GO WEST** was not a factor.
