IMANATIVENEWYORKER firmly rated the pace inside, came under pressure nearing the three sixteenths pole and dug in to steady stretch encouragement to hold on. SUCCESSFULPRINCESS settled off the pace off the rail, bid leaving the five sixteenths pole and was inching closer late yards. APPEALETTA settled back outside, bid leaving the seven sixteenths pole, rounded the final turn about the three path and closed to late stretch before leveling off. SALTY TEMPER, well back off the rail, bid leaving the three eighths pole, improved in the two path of the final turn but proved empty down the lane. COLARFUL SONG, off the pace about the three path, made a mild bid saving ground approaching the final turn. SHIRLEYCEE, off the pace inside, showed no response from the seven sixteenths pole. INTIMATE STORM rated off the early pace about the three path then faded through the backstretch.
