TERMSOFENDEARMENT saved ground, angled three wide on the turn, drew off through the stretch while kept to a drive. KEYSOFT rallied along the inside on the turn, split foes late for second. DIANA DEER well placed, had no rally. REACTION TIME forced the pace three and four wide, failed to respond. LOOSE CHANGE advanced five wide but was too late. BLASTING showed early speed but was no threat. WAYLAY failed to menace. PIC VERA passed tiring rivals. BET IT ALL forced the pace for a half then tired. ADAM LETS SHARE made a clear lead for a half then stopped.
