Footnotes

ABU RACER advanced four wide to reach contention on the turn, gained the lead approaching the sixteenth pole and quickly drew off. WESTWARD BOUND off the pace four wide, rallied on the turn to become prominent and while unable to gain on the winner was second best. QUARTERBACK SNEAK prompted the issue three wide, was in good position on the turn but lacked a closing bid when asked in the lane. PASSING LANE forced the pace from the rail, lacked a late response. CAT PRINTS set the pace on the rail, held clear until the turn then gave way in the drive. MAMBO'S VOODOO stumbled after the start and was soundly bumped, showed little three wide. HARDROCK KID pressed the issue just off the rail, had little left for the drive. STRIKE OR SPARE bore in at the start, soundly bumped with CAROLINA BARON, trailed throughout along the inside. CAROLINA BARON soundly bumped at the start, swerved to avoid the fallen rider into the turn and subsequently lost his rider. ZIPPY CAT RULES clipped heels with QUARTERBACK SNEAK into the turn, stumbled and lost his rider.
