STORMIN' YANKEE rated a short lead inside, turned back rivals leaving the three eighths pole and widened under steady stretch handling. FREE HUMOR settled close about the three path, took aim at the three eighths pole, couldn't match strides with the winner though dueled for place. BOLD CONQUERER settled off the pace two deep, bid at the rail from the five sixteenths pole then outfinished in the duel for place. THE RAVEN KING rated close to the early pace inside, gave chase from the three eighths pole, faded into the final turn then eased to mid track and finished evenly. BAMFER saved ground to the quarter pole, came through the turn five wide and leveled off in the lane. TOUCHER was not a factor. NEW MILLENNIUM raced six wide the first turn, mid track on the second turn, stalked the pace down the backstretch, showed no response on the final turn then leveled out in the stretch under a rider that stood up before the wire. SANSAR MOUNTAIN saved ground. DERWINS PROSPECTOR was not a factor. WHAT A WILDCAT settled off the pace off the rail, showed no response on the final turn and faded through the lane.
