**Footnotes**

FLORACITA stalked the pace four wide, bumped with SPICY SPIRIT nearing the far turn, continued four wide around the turn, rallied outside and up was up late. GETTIN OUT QUICK pressed the pace from the rail, cut the corner to take the lead turning for home and led until deep stretch. SPICY SPIRIT chased the pace three wide between foes, bumped with the winner nearing the far turn, advanced three wide between foes around the turn, raced between rivals in the lane and was outfinished. GOODWOOD GAL pressed the pace between foes down the backstretch, checked entering the turn, swung five wide and was no further threat. UNHINCHED set the pace two wide down the backstretch and tired nearing the lane. HEART SEEKER checked when in a bit tight near the seven-sixteenths pole, saved ground around the turn and hit the rail in upper stretch.
