WIMAUMA MAMA set all the pace inside, rated well down the backstretch then drew off through the stretch under a drive. MARY CARLISLE pressed the pace three wide, dropped to the rail on the turn then was all out to hold second. PRETTY DEELITEFUL advanced just off the rail, finished willingly. PARSIPPANY prompted the pace along the rail, lacked a late response. FINISH 'EM OFF stalked the pace three wide, failed to respond. T. V. SECRETARY was no threat five wide. PRESS BEYOND never was a factor three wide. YOU'LL BE HAPPY saved ground to no avail. DOLLY'S WAGER showed little inside. EXCEEDINLEGALLIMIT showed early speed, steadily faded.
