Footnotes

I GOT'M was unhurried while saving ground around the first turn, dropped back entering the far turn, rallied in the two path around that bend, split horses leaving the eighth pole, angled to the rail, steadily gained through the lane and was up in the final strides. SPEEDY TUXEDO stalked the pace two wide around the first turn, bid outside down the backstretch, took the lead near the five-sixteenths pole, widened while still racing two wide around the far turn, dug in in upper stretch, led to deep stretch and was caught in the final strides. ROOSTER PIE lacked speed while racing off the rail around the first turn, moved up three wide around the far turn, angled further outside in upper stretch and rallied through the lane to gain the show late. WESH'S TEXAS STAR stalked the pace along the inside early, eased four wide midway down the backstretch, slowly gained while racing three wide around the far turn, loomed in upper stretch then flattened out in the final sixteenth. NICOLE'S PROSPECT prompted the pace two wide early, took the lead near the half-mile pole, was collared near the quarter pole, vied inside of SPEEDY TUXEDO around the far turn then tired in the stretch. LORD PARKER set the pace along the rail and faltered down the backstretch.
