

TIMELESS MISS chased the pace well back and off the rail, flattened stride through the lane, was unsaddled near the chute, appeared sore and vanned home. APPEALING SISTER showed no speed from well back and off the rail. SINGA SONGFOR SLEW was outrun saving ground. MAKIN THE BLUES was not a factor. SCORE ONE MORE gave distant chase while off the rail then faded while losing ground through the turn.
