Footnotes

HANDY DANDY was unhurried in the three path around the first turn, advanced between rivals down the backstretch, rallied three wide between horses around the far turn, took command turning for home, continued on his left lead and prevailed under strong left-handed urging. UP TO MISCHIEF steadied soon after the start, lacked speed in the five path, advanced outside down the backstretch, bid five wide around the far turn, vied outside of the winner through the lane and just missed. BLACKBERRY WINTER bobbled at the start, quickly recovered to set the pace between rivals around the first turn, cleared and angled in near the three-eighths pole, set the pace along the rail around the far turn, was collared in upper stretch, faded but lasted for the show. GENERAL RUTLEDGE was unhurried while racing in the four path early, advanced three wide around the far turn and lacked the needed stretch rally. SCOOTER TAX stalked the pace in the two path and in the clear and faded after a half. INALEAGUEOFMYOWN disputed the pace along the rail around the first turn, settled back down the backstretch, chased three wide around the far turn, came five wide into the lane and tired. WEWEWEALLDAYHOME disputed the pace three wide around the first turn, prompted two wide around the far turn and faltered in the stretch. WHITE POST raced along the rail, stopped and was eased.
